Attached is First Steps' response to your fiscal request dated November 12, 2015. We have included it in the spreadsheet requested by the Committee.

We appreciate the State Department of Education who had staff go back into their previous financial system and pull out all of the data for SC First Steps for the years from 2000 to 2009. Their system was not able to run reports for 2008 and 2009 breaking out the categories that were detailed during 2000 to 2007, even after several attempts, but were able to report summary information. The spreadsheet breaks out the detail that was available for each of the years. The total budget amounts and total expenditure amounts are correct, per their system.

All available financial data has been included in the spreadsheet. We do have copies of the green bar financial reports from the State Department of Education's system on file and will be happy to provide them. Please let me know if you have any questions.
