SC First Steps Legislation:
 Section 59.152.130. (A) Local partnerships shall provide an annual match of at least fifteen percent, to include private donations, grant funds, and in kind donated resources, or any combination of them. The South Carolina First Steps to School Readiness Board of Trustees may decrease this percentage requirement for a partnership based on their capacity to provide that match.
