

Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP)

Performance Measures

1. **Hours of Community Service Employment**-means part-time, temporary employment paid with grant funds in projects at host agencies through which eligible individuals are engaged in community service and receive work experience and job skills that can lead to unsubsidized unemployment. The term community service assignment is used interchangeably with community service employment. Hours of community service employment is defined as the total number of hours of community service provided by SCSEP participants divided by the number of hours of community service funded by the grant, after adjusting for differences in minimum wage among the states and areas. Paid training hours are excluded from this measure.
2. **Percentage of participants who are in unsubsidized employment during the second quarter after exit from the program**- this measure is defined by the following formula: of those who are not employed at the date of participation, the number of participants who are employed in the first quarter after the exit quarter divided by the number of adult participants who exit during the quarter.
3. **Percentage of participants who are in unsubsidized employment during the fourth quarter after exit from the program**- This measure is defined by the formula: of those who are employed in the first quarter after the exit quarter, the number of adult participants who are employed in both the second and third quarters after the exit quarter divided by the number of adult participants who exit during the quarter.
4. **Earnings**- The median earnings of project participants who are in unsubsidized employment during the second quarter after exit from the project.

5. **Indicators in the effectiveness in serving employers, host agencies and project participants-** Retention in unsubsidized employment for one year; Satisfaction of the participants , employers, and their host agencies with their experiences and the services provided; and any other indicators of performance that the Secretary determines to be appropriate to evaluate services and performance.
6. **The number of eligible individuals served-** The total number of participants served divided by grantee's authorized number of positions after adjusting for differences in the minimum wage among states.
7. **Most-in-Need-** Participants are characterized most-in-need if they:
- Have a severe disability
 - Are frail
 - Are age 75 or older
 - Meet the eligibility requirements related to age for, but do not receive , benefits under Title II of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 401 et seq.)
 - Live in area with persistent unemployment and are individuals with severely limited employment prospects
 - Have limited English proficiency
 - Have low literacy skills
 - Have a disability
 - Reside in a rural area
 - Are veterans
 - Have low employment prospects
 - Have failed to find employment after utilizing the services provided under WIOA
 - Are homeless or at risk of homelessness
 - Are formerly incarcerated (5 years)
