The House Legislative Oversight Committee is reviewing the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Tourism. Recently, the Executive Subcommittee leading this review has been informed the Department no longer maintains the Fort Watson Revolutionary War Memorial. Instead, this landmark, on the National Register of Historic Places, is the property of the Public Service Authority. Maintaining the public's access to this landmark is an issue of importance.
