
## Number of UCC filings: UCC-1 Financing Statement and UCC-3 Amendment (FY 2015-16 – FY 2018-19)<sup>13</sup>

A secured party may file a notice of a security interest with the Secretary of State by filing a UCC -1 Financing Statement. All subsequent records filed relating to a particular financing statement are linked to that initial financing statement. Filers may also use a UCC -1 Addendum to provide additional information to the UCC -1 Financing Statement.

A person may file a UCC-3 Amendment with the Secretary of State tracking changes to a UCC-1 for the following: (a) to continue a financing statement; (b) to amend a financing statement; (c) to terminate a financing statement; or (d) to assign a security interest.
