
## Number of Business Filings Rejections (FY 2015-16 – FY 2018-19)8

When a customer attempts to file a document that does not meet statutory requirements, the Secretary of State's Office will reject the filing and return it to the filer with a brief written explanation of the reason the filing was rejected. An entity may file an appeal with the Richland County Circuit Court following a refusal by the Secretary of State to file a document. During the time covered by the performance evaluation report, no appeals of the Secretary of State's refusal to file a document were filed with the court.
