## Sample Certificate of Vote<sup>53</sup>

Before the Electoral College meeting, the Secretary of State prepares certificates of vote to be signed by the electors at the meeting. In addition, the Governor prepares nine certificates of ascertainment which set forth: (a) names of the candidates for president and vice president; (b) names of the electors; and (c) number of votes received by each. The Governor sends three certificates of ascertainment directly to the Archivist of the United States prior to the Electoral College meeting, and sends to the remaining certificates to the Secretary of State. The certificates of ascertainment are affixed to the certificates of vote at the Electoral College meeting.

On the first Monday after the second Wednesday in December following the presidential election, at 11:00 AM, the Secretary of State convenes the meeting of the South Carolina Electoral College. At the meeting, each of the nine electors signs certificates of vote for President and Vice-President. The Secretary of State then signs the certificates of vote to certify the election. Additionally, the certificates of ascertainment are affixed to the certificates of vote. Under Section 7-19-110, electors are entitled to mileage, subsistence and per diem to be paid from appropriations to the Secretary of State's Office.

Following the Electoral College meeting, the Secretary of State delivers the certificates of vote and certificates of ascertainment to the following entities: (a) One certificate of vote and one certificate of ascertainment are mailed to the President of the United States Senate; (b) Two certificates of vote and two certificates of ascertainment are mailed to the Archivist of the United States; and (c) One certificate of vote and one certificate of ascertainment are mailed to the federal judge of the district where the electors assembled. The Secretary of State also keeps two certificates of vote and two certificates of ascertainment on file.
