DSS Director Alford stated that the agency is engaged in a "targeted recruitment campaign for foster homes," because of a lack of appropriate placements. Several of my constituents have relayed recent negative experiences with DSS during attempts to become foster parents, and after they have become foster parents — which leads me to believe that the agency has many improvements to make in order to be able to meet the need for foster homes.

I would like to request that the Healthcare Subcommittee inquire into the Department of Social Service's process to become a foster parent. I would also like to request study of the support that approved foster parents receive, and that the Subcommittee make recommendations regarding the process.

If this is not within the scope of the Healthcare Subcommittee's study, please consider requesting that Chairman Newton direct the Legislative Audit Council perform a review of the agency's program evaluation report's data on the foster care process.
