SENATOR ALEXANDER: I'm going to call the meeting to order of the State Regulation of Public Utilities Review Committee, May 3rd, 2016.

And we've -- I want to thank the members of the Public Service Commission Screening Subcommittee and we'll be considering their report at the appropriate time.

First, I want to recognize the Senator from Orangeburg, Senator Hutto, who chairs the PSC Screening Subcommittee. Good morning.

SENATOR HUTTO: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. The Subcommittee -- PSC Subcommittee of the PURC met on April the 18th to screen candidates for the Public Service Commission. We screened candidates for Districts 1, 3, 5 and 7 whose terms are set to expire on June the 30th, 2016. Following the screening three applicants withdrew their name from consideration and -- I mean, excuse me, prior to screening three applicants withdrew their names from consideration so they were not screened. And after screening two of the candidates who were applicants who were screened withdrew from consideration.

So today we have before us the remaining candidates who have not withdrawn who wish to go forward with the seats and I'll read those as

follows. District 1, Johnny "Butch" Howard and Carolee Williams. In District 3 -- 3, Comer "Randy" Randall. In District 5, William Billy Hagner and Swain Whitfield. And in District 7, Clara Brockington and O'Neal Hamilton.

And so it's those remaining candidates that we have to present to the full PURC here today for consideration and we will -- I think first, before we go any further, go ahead and pursuant to 30-4-70(a)(1), I move that the Committee meet in executive session to discuss the following matters as relates to the Committee screening for PSC Seats 1, 3, 5 and 7, as well as matters of a personal nature where public disclosure would constitute unreasonable invasion of the candidate's privacy which are exempt from public disclosure pursuant to Section SC Code 30-4-40(a)(2).


