

To create a healing space to serve as a venue for engaging, educating, empowering and enhancing the lives of survivors















\$10 Million+ Raised for CSP by CSPA

- Over 80% are private donors and foundations
- City and County donations of \$2Million (City \$1.5M and County \$.5M)
- \$2.8 Million current capital campaign to raise includes:
- \$1.09 Million infrastructure debt
- \$1 Million Endowment with Community Foundation
- \$600,000+ for signage completion and contingencies
