Summary

Priority 1: Military Enhancement Fund

Recurring: \$10,000,000 Non-recurring: \$0

These funds allow the department to continue the highly successful grant program enabling communities near military installations to improve operational capacity or quality of life.

The General Assembly's passage of legislation to add Fort Gordon (Augusta Georgia) to the list of federal military installations for South Carolina underscores the importance of the corresponding \$1.8B economic impact to South Carolina. As a result, South Carolina counties of Edgefield and Aiken are eligible to participate in the Military Enhancement Fund program.

Key Take-away

The Department's request for \$10M underwrites the state's commitment as an indispensable component of U.S. National Defense. Moreover, this level of funding further sets conditions for posturing South Carolina as the most attractive location for military bases and military families—through projects that increase military value and military installation resilience and enhance military family quality of life at supported military installations.

Military Enhancement Fund - Project Examples (Expanded)

Operational Readiness

1. Creation of a Shipboard Firefighting Training Facility in Charleston County to train firefighters to handle a shipboard fire in the Port of Charleston or along the coast.

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
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2. Agency Overview (Mission, Major Programs and Organizational Chart)

Mission: The South Carolina Department of Veterans' Affairs leads and enables a state-wide coalition of partners with an interest in Veterans to create and sustain an environment in which Veterans and service members can thrive as valued and contributing members of the South Carolina community.

Major Programs: South Carolina Veteran Coalition, Workforce Enhancement - Marketing and Recruitment of South Carolina Smart Start¹ (the department's decisive operation is Workforce Enhancement), Palmetto Pathfinder, Veterans Treatment Court and Transitional Housing Grants, Virtual Transition Assistance, Mobile Service, Governor's Summit, Veteran Service Officer Accreditation, Memorialization and Care and Upkeep of the State Veteran Cemetery, Claims Benefit Assistance, Free-Tuition Program for Eligible Children of Veterans, War Roster Archive, Military Enhancement Fund, Military Affairs Advisory Council, (Military Base) Commander's Brief to the Governor and Veterans' Trust Fund of South Carolina Support.

3. Budget Request / important information we would like the members to be aware of.

The department's budget request is distributed across a single focus area within the construct of our strategic plan: Focus Area 5 - Expand the Military Enterprise with the intent to make South Carolina an indispensable component of the nation's defense. This budget request reflects our state's commitment to underwrite the State's support for improving (1) the operational capability of a South Carolina military installation and (2) the quality of life of military families in South Carolina.

My budget request for Fiscal Year 2026-2027 is nominal at 6% (or \$10M) when considering the General Assembly's generous prior-year appropriation approvals across the range of programs and services the department delivers to a special segment of South Carolinians. As the department looks forward beyond the recent transition of the State Veteran Home Enterprise from the Office of Mental Health, my request of \$10M sustains and expands the nation's military presence in South Carolina.

- a. Sustainment and expansion set conditions for continuous deliberate engagement in the years ahead; especially when considering shrinking national defense budgets.
- b. The General Assembly's passage of legislation to add Fort Gordon (Augusta Georgia) to the list of federal military installations for South Carolina underscores the importance of the corresponding \$1.8B economic impact to South Carolina. As a result, South Carolina counties of Edgefield and Aiken are eligible to participate in the Military Enhancement Fund program.

4. Proviso Request(s):

Am requesting continuation of existing FY25-26 Provisos (below). Each of our existing Provisos are critical for enabling the department's ability to sustain and enhance existing and implement new programs and services that further expand opportunities for Veterans and their Families to thrive.

SECTION 101 - E260 - DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS

101.1. (VET: M.J. "Dolly" Cooper Veterans Cemetery Carry Forward) The Department of Veterans' Affairs may carry forward unexpended funds appropriated and/or authorized for the M.J. "Dolly" Cooper Veterans Cemetery from the prior fiscal year and shall use such funds for the same purpose. In addition, any unexpended funds in the Department of Veterans' Affairs, including Special Line Items, may be carried forward from the prior fiscal year into the current SECTION 101 - E260 - DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS' AFFAIRS PAGE 476 fiscal year. Funds carried forward in excess of the amount needed for the operation of the Cemetery may be used for other expenses of the Department of Veterans' Affairs.

101.2. (VET: Budget Reduction Exemption) Funds appropriated for the Department of Veterans' Affairs shall be excluded from any across-the-board agency base reductions mandated by the Executive Budget Office or General Assembly.

101.3. (VET: Military Enhancement Fund Allocation) Funds appropriated to the department for the Military Enhancement Fund may be allocated to items including, but not limited to, land acquisition, recreational purposes, educational purposes, and facilities for military personnel. Eligible recipients are counties and municipalities with federal military installations.

101.4. (VET: Veterans' Home Fund) The Department of Veterans' Affairs is authorized to establish an interest-bearing fund in the State Treasury for funds appropriated or authorized for the operation of State Veterans Homes. The fund shall be used for operations, deferred maintenance, capital projects, ordinary repair, and maintenance of the State Veterans Homes and may be carried forward from the prior fiscal year into the current fiscal year to be used for the same purpose.

101.5. (VET: Resident Fee Account) The Department of Veterans' Affairs is hereby authorized to retain and expend its Resident Fee Account funds. In addition to funds collected for the maintenance and medical care for patients, Medicare funds collected by the department from residents' Medicare benefits and funds collected by the department from its veteran facilities shall be considered as resident fees. The department is authorized to expend these funds for departmental operations, capital improvements, and debt service under the provisions of Act 1276 of 1970, and for the cost of patients' Medicare Part B premiums.

There are two supporting components in which the Department focused on in concert with the transition of the last of the State Veteran Homes from the Office of Mental Health: (1) employee capability and capacity and (2) setting conditions for aligning costs and implementing continuous review and analysis of programs and services to assess return on investment (cost to the taxpayer versus benefit to Veterans and their Families).







Fundamentally, fiscal stewardship remains the mainstay of how my department views all resources appropriated by the General Assembly. We exercise fiscal prudence by facilitating and enabling a leader-led cost culture where programs and services are delivered in a way and at a cost that is informed by our ability to translate data into information -- in order to drive and / or enable calculated risk-based decisions when deciding to resource a program or services for a special population of South Carolinians.

One efficiency highlight is the direct correlation is the hiring of a seasoned facilities maintenance management subject matter expert (i.e., Deputy Director of Facilities Management) who identified opportunities to group 'like' capital projects thereby resulting in a cost of avoidance of \$863,000 for expense - repair projects.

A second example of efficiency is our implementation of detailed recurring periodic reviews of our ground transportation utilization posture (i.e., fleet vs non-fleet). Our review revealed an opportunity to reallocate state fleet vehicles for regional (intra-state) usage and thereby resulting in a 50% or \$5.5K less costs in ground transportation expenses.

Finally, our deliberate approach for quarterly, department-level, review and analysis of budget / spending has matured. We are now better able to reallocate fiscal resources earlier when a shift in requirements change and / or an emerging requirement becomes present—in order to accelerate speed to outcomes and achieve associated effects.

FY24-25 Successes (highlights) continued.

Claims and Appeals. In FY24-26, the Department and the 46 County Veterans' Affairs Offices provided assistance to 21,611 previously unserved Veterans and assisted in the filing of 13,606 federal claims.

- Service officers assigned to the department filed a total of 1,172 Veteran claims.
- County offices filed a total of 9,626 Veteran claims the department can verify, and an additional 2,808 Veteran claims the department cannot verify.
[The department can verify only those claims submitted through the state-provided electronics claims management system. For those counties that do not use this system, we rely upon their self-reporting.]

Support to Veterans at US Department of Veterans’ Affairs Medical Centers. In FY24-25, state service officers at the US Department of Veterans’ Affairs medical centers in Columbia submitted over 1,000 actions on behalf of Veterans receiving healthcare from the facility. Similarly, state service officers at the US Department of Veterans’ Affairs medical center in North Charleston submitted 947 actions.

Veterans Experience Action Centers. In coordination with the US Department of Veterans’ Affairs, the American Legion, the Veterans of Foreign Wars, and other partners, we participated in three major community outreach events in FY24-25. These events provided services and information to a total of 1,973 South Carolina Veterans.

Veteran Hearings and Appeals. During FY24-25, the Department assisted Veterans and their families with 238 appeals to the US Department of Veterans’ Affairs Board of Veteran Appeals and 113 Pre-Determination Hearings; which enables swifter decision for Veterans seeking redress on earlier US Department of Veterans’ Affairs decisions.

M.J. “Dolly” Cooper State Veterans’ Cemetery.

- During this year, the Cemetery interred 479 remains (341 Veterans and 138 dependents), including:
 - 317 below-ground burials
 - 157 columbarium niche placements
 - 5 scatterings
- We denied 3 ineligible requests for interment.
- We processed 319 requests for pre-certification (advance arrangement for future burial). Of these:
 - we approved 301
 - we denied 18 as ineligible
 - three were withdrawn by the Veteran or family member (interred elsewhere or moved out of state).

South Carolina Free Tuition for Certain War Veterans’ Children Program (SC Code 59-111-20).

In FY24-25, we received 2,074 applications for this program. We approved 1,510, denying 564 applications as ineligible. Primary reasons for denial remain the residency requirement for the student and Veteran, and the Veteran not having served during one of the specified periods of wartime service.

War Records (SC Code 25-11-90). In the past fiscal year, we made no progress in scanning hardcopy Form DD-214s into the electronic War Record. We currently have 104,846 records scanned, representing 29.12% of the total number of paper records in the Department's possession. The department continues to seek an automated process to address the backlog of digitizing paper copy records.

Veteran Service Organization Honor Guard Reimbursement Program (SC Code 25-11-85). In FY24-25, we disbursed \$54,000 to eleven Veteran Service Organizations Honor Guard organizations that provided military honors at Veteran funerals across the state.

Veteran Homes. A summary is provided in Table 4.

- In FY24-25, the department provided oversight for five Veteran Homes that transferred from the Department of Mental Health on 1 July, 2024.
 - Four homes were operational at the time of transfer and continued to function under the contracted operator.
 - Patriots Village in Sumter, was not operational at the time of transfer.
 - The facility opened to the public on 1 March, 2025.
 - The facility passed its recognition survey conducted by the US Department of Veterans' Affairs on 17 July, 2025 (after FY24-25) and is now authorized to operate at its full capacity of 104 residents.
- Throughout FY24-25, the department worked with the Office of Mental Health (previously the Department of Mental Health) and the Department of Administration to prepare for the transfer of Stone Pavilion Veteran Home in Columbia on 1 July 25.
 - On 1 July 25, the department assumed responsibility for Stone Pavilion Veteran Home.
 - Simultaneously, the facility transitioned from a state-run long-term care facility to a contractor-operated facility with state oversight.

South Carolina Veteran Coalition. A web-based platform that allows the department and our partners to provide electronic referrals to Veterans in need. The platform serves as a one-stop tool that Veterans and their family members can use to access organizations that help in critical areas of well-being; such as employment, housing, financial aid, food insecurity and social connections. Partners must respond to requests for support within 72 hours and both Veteran and partner are rated on their performance of system use. This Salesforce-based system improves the efficiency of services; while developing a rich picture of Veteran needs over time. Our web-based electronic platform for connecting Veterans to services continued to grow in membership and usage. In FY24-25, we enrolled an additional 33 organizations in the Coalition; bringing the total number of partners to 139 and made 4,300 Veteran-to-service provider connections.

Reducing Veteran Suicide.

In FY24-25, the department introduced: (1) the *Lock It South Carolina* Lethal Means Safety campaign to encourage Veterans and their families to practice the safe storage of firearms, (2) the safe disposal of medication and (3) regular safety planning to make Veterans aware of resources available during a time of crisis. In its first year, we believe this campaign reached about 1,000 Veteran families.

In partnership with the US Department of Veterans Affairs, the department (1) provided gun locks to all County Veterans Affairs Offices for free distribution to Veteran families, (2) integrated gun lock education into our Palmetto Pathfinder training and (3) distributed 300 gun locks at eight outreach events in which the department participated.

The two-year data lag in Veteran suicide data means the effect of these efforts will not be reflected in the near-term.

Reducing Veteran Unemployment. As of 30 June, 2025, Veteran unemployment was at 3.5%; well below the general population rate of 4.2%. Given this long-established and enduring trend, in FY24-25 we began setting the conditions for an internal reorganization allowing us to provide a focused effort on enhancing the value of Veterans to the South Carolina economy in the years ahead. This effort will include recruiting Veterans into the South Carolina workforce, assisting Veterans in obtaining training and education to make them more effective and aiding those Veterans interested in pursuing state entrepreneurial opportunities.

Improving the Availability of Housing. In FY24-25, we provided \$2,345,064 in grant funding to 13 recipient organizations nonprofits and public agencies offering essential services; such as housing assistance, food security, emergency utility support and substance abuse recovery programs.

Palmetto Pathfinder Program. In FY24-25, we trained 75 new peer-mentor Pathfinders and connected 136 Veterans with a trained Pathfinder to provide peer support and assist in obtaining services. 50 of the Veterans connected to a Pathfinder were service members transitioning from military service, the optimal target audience for this program.

Veteran Treatment Courts. We continued our use of a Federal Bureau of Justice grant to implement Veteran Treatment Courts in the following circuits: Second Judicial Circuit (Aiken County), Fourth Judicial Circuit (Chesterfield and Darlington Counties) and Twelfth Judicial Circuit (Florence County). We used funds from the same grant to enhance Veteran Treatment Court services in the Eighth Judicial Circuit (Greenwood County) and Ninth Judicial Circuit (Charleston County). Across the state, 19 Veterans participated in Veteran Treatment Courts funded with subawards from the department. We have received an additional federal grant enabling our ability to maintain these Veteran Treatment Courts through 2028.

Military Enhancement. The eight major military installations in South Carolina, including Fort Gordon in Augusta, Georgia, provide a \$34.3 billion economic impact on the state of South Carolina. These installations cover every branch of service except the Space Force and provide vital training, combat, and support service resources in support of national defense.

In FY24-25, the department assisted these installations and their associated military communities with challenges related to both the operational readiness of the installation and the quality of life of our active-duty service members and families. A summary of the past year includes:

- Operational Readiness
 - Provided a Military Enhancement Fund grant for a Shipboard Firefighting Training Facility in Charleston County. This facility will be used to train area firefighters to handle a shipboard fire in the Port of Charleston or along the coast. This facility can also be used to bring other states to South Carolina for shipboard firefighting training.
 - Provided a Military Enhancement Fund grant for computer equipment to outfit the Regional Support Operations Center and the Sensitive Compartmented Information Facility at the University of South Carolina-Aiken Cyber Integration Center.
- Quality of Life
 - Provided a Military Enhancement Fund grant for a new pump station at the Laurel Bay Wastewater Treatment Plant; which services military installations and the military community in Beaufort County.
 - Provided a Military Enhancement Fund grant for new disinfectant equipment at the Port Royal Wastewater Reclamation Facility; which serves military installations and the military community in Beaufort County.
 - Provided a Military Enhancement Fund grant for the completion of the design, surveying, property easement and coverage for permits costs for the Wastewater project at the Short Stay Recreation Area for Joint Base Charleston service members and their families.
 - Worked with Fort Jackson and the South Carolina Department of Education to plan and execute the Military Honor Cord Ceremony for high school graduates across the state who are entering the military. The event was held at Fort Jackson and had record attendance.
 - Assisted Beaufort Naval Hospital in a partnership with Winn Army Medical Center at Fort Stewart Georgia, to provide Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners when there are none available in Beaufort.
 - Worked with the South Carolina Department of Education to increase the number of Purple Star Designated School Districts and Charter Schools that aid military families and students as they transition schools during their assignment in South Carolina.
 - Worked with the South Carolina Department of Social Services to increase the number of childcare facilities in the Military Child Care in Your Neighborhood Plus Pilot Program in South Carolina; making it easier for service members to find childcare and receive assistance with covering childcare fees.

In this fiscal year, the Military Enhancement Fund awarded five grants (detailed above) with a total value of \$9,504,325.

Way Ahead (Future Budget Requests). The Department continues a posture of generating better-informed insights for revenue and expenditure forecasting. As a result of my team's ability to **establish and implement dynamic financial modeling, the Department is able to gain a much higher level of confidence with cost-performance objectives** to operate and support our unique group of South Carolinians (Veterans and their Families).

To this end, am better able to assess forecasting of revenue and expenditures and 'meter' our Recurring Appropriation for the Veteran Home Enterprise. **FY26-27 starts a multi-year campaign to 'right-size' our Recurring Appropriation request for resourcing the Veteran Home Enterprise.** For example, **my budget request for FY26-27 does not include an increase above our current Recurring Appropriation.**

Moreover, **it is plausible that I may seek a reduction in Recurring Appropriation for the Veteran Home Enterprise as my Department seeks to 'strike the right balance' / mix of external revenue and Recurring Appropriation to resource the Veteran Home Enterprise,** when considering a projected \$28M year-over-year Carry-Forward starting this Fiscal Year.

At first glance, I anticipate establishing a 'floor' of \$10M Carry-Forward to **(1) bolster my ability to avoid insolvency** (i.e., inability to pay Contractor-operator invoices for the day-to-day management and operations for each of the six State Veteran Homes) and **(2) enable the Department's rapid response for resolving, for example, inclement weather-related catastrophic facility damage** (e.g., heating and cooling system or lightning protection area repair or replacement and restore essential services (e.g., power generation and water purification)).

My above assessment encompasses two critical underlying assumptions: **(1) continuation of current Provisos** enabling the Department's ability to Carry-Forward 100% of Recurring Appropriations and Revenue for operating the Veteran Home Enterprise and **(2) the need to exhaust a relative sizeable Carry-Forward to resource critical and essential facility infrastructure (e.g., mechanical, plumbing and electrical, roof) requirements is unlikely;** with a moderate degree of confidence.

A two-year horizon and subsequent analyses enable a laser-focused 'view' of revenue to expenditure analyses. We are then able to achieve a better understanding of revenue and expenditures for two [unique homes] Stone Pavilion (Columbia) and Patriots Village (Sumter). We would receive and be able to better assess (1) a full year of external revenue and expenditures for both facilities (e.g., self-pay by Residents, healthcare insurance revenue and per diem [reimbursement] from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and (2) facility Resident Occupancy; respectively.
