




# SCDOR Organizational Chart

### Maintaining a Secure Environment

- The Department of Administration has approved a statement of work for SCDOR's transition to the Microsoft Cloud Platform.
- Staying ahead of cyber-security threats is a constant challenge, and moving to a cloud-based platform will equip SCDOR with the most advanced security technology.
- Cloud-based platforms come at a higher cost for SCDOR due to stringent IRS security requirements, and these costs have increased significantly due to inflation.
- Therefore, SCDOR needs an additional \$15M in authority to fund the continued transition to the cloud.
