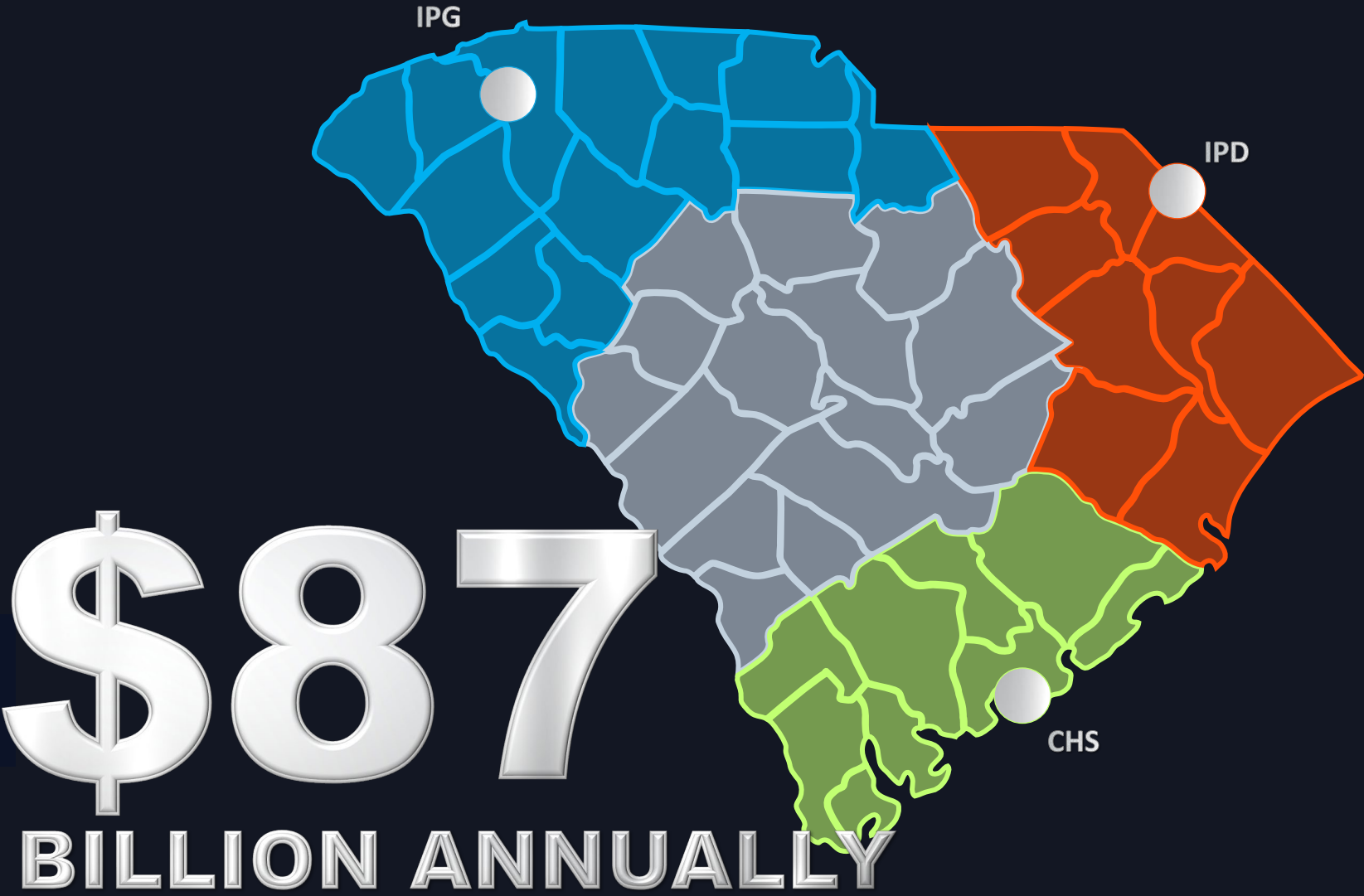

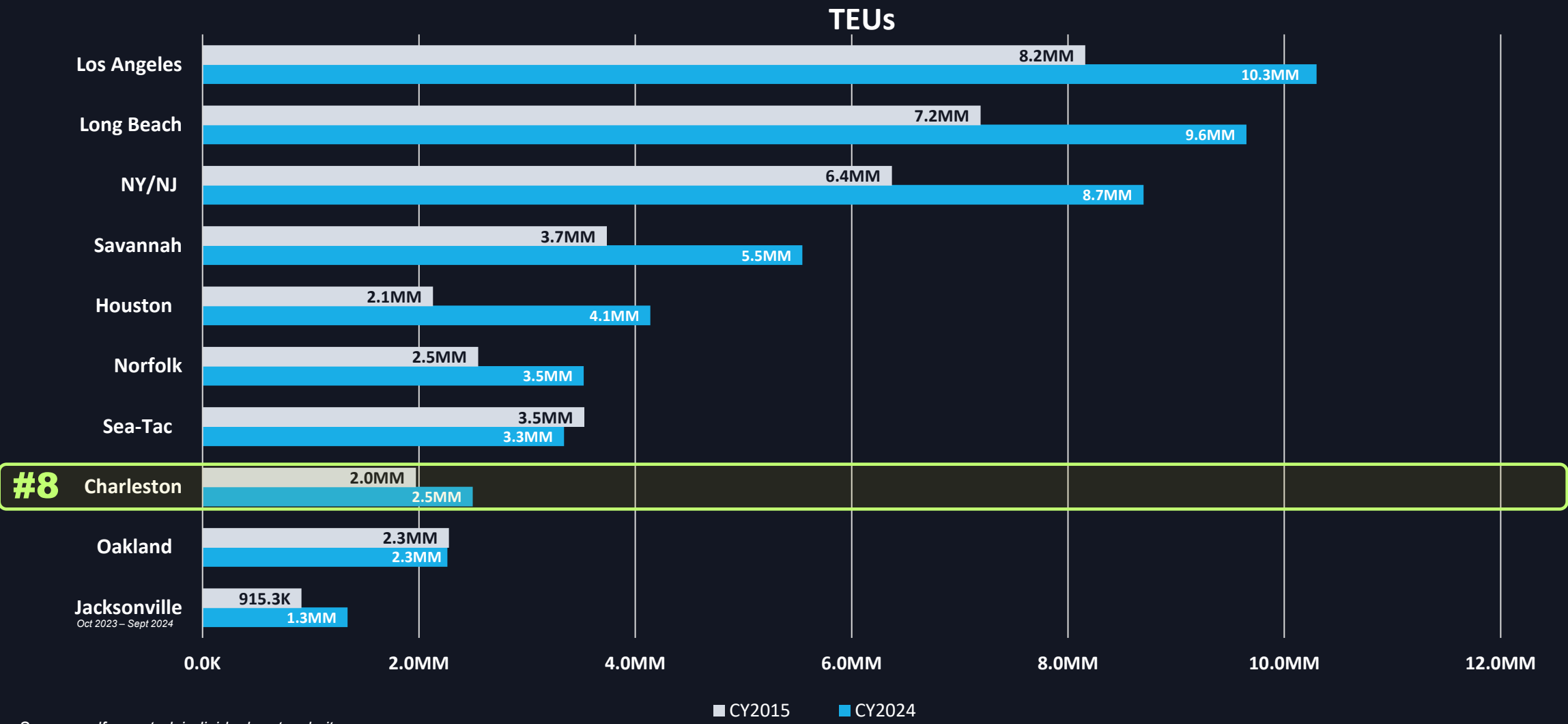

2024 TOP 10 US CONTAINER PORTS

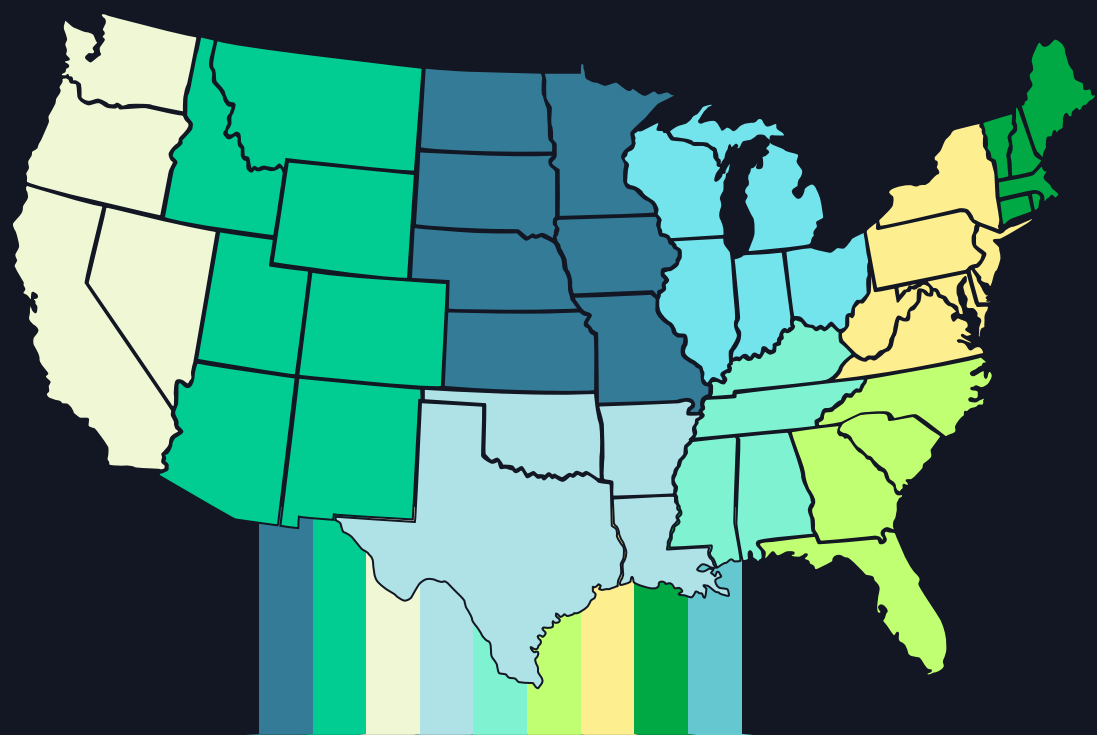
TEU 10-YEAR PERIOD COMPARISON / CY2015 – CY2024
