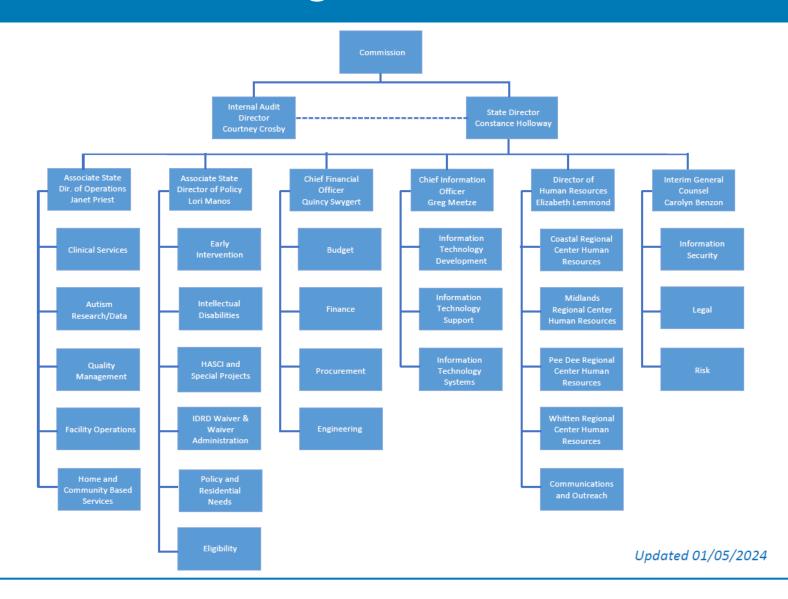

- Majority of other funds Carry Forward is in Medicaid fund, due to 6.2% Enhanced FMAP savings
- Carryforward is currently being utilized for Regional Center Renovations, Provider Grant Awards, Pilot of Behavioral Support Service and funding of awarded solicitations for state-wide bed expansion (Youth and Adult)
