#### 55 poison centers serve the entire US

- Operate 24/7: Mission to reduce harm tied to poisoning and toxin-related injury
- Nurses, pharmacists, physicians
- Free, confidential
- Language line for non-English speakers

#### **Palmetto Poison Center**



#### Only Poison Center in SC for all 46 counties

- Over 30,000 human exposure calls annually
  - 53% cases involve children
  - 25% from healthcare professionals
  - 90% safely managed at home

Over 61,000 points of contact with SC citizens
