(A) The members of the Board of Trustees of South 3 Carolina State University currently serving on the effective date of 4 this joint resolution are hereby removed from service and the powers 5 and duties of the board are transferred to and devolved upon the 6 State Budget and Control Board. The State Budget and Control Board is directed to remove the current president of South Carolina 8 State University and is directed to employ an interim chief executive 9 officer who shall serve at-will at the pleasure of the State Budget 10 and Control Board.

(B) The interim chief executive officer whose actions must be 12 overseen by the board shall review both the educational accreditation of the university and the past and current financial 14 situation of the university and make recommendations both to the 15 board and to the General Assembly regarding the path that the 16 university must pursue in order to lead the university out of the 17 current financial crisis with an emphasis on having the university 18 return to the valuable and functional institution of higher learning
