S. 1134 -- Senator McGill: A BILL TO AMEND ACT 1377 OF 1968, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BOND AUTHORIZATIONS, SO AS TO REVISE THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BOND AUTHORIZATIONS MAY BE USED AT WILLIAMSBURG TECHNICAL COLLEGE.

Summary of Bill:

The bill repurposes \$700,000 of Capital Improvement Bond Authorizations designated for a new technology building at Williamsburg Technical College and instead authorizes it to be used for academic program support and building repair, maintenance and renovation.

Other Notes/Comments:

The capital bond bill passed in 2000 appropriated \$1 million to Williamsburg Tech for a new technology building. In 2004, the General Assembly repurposed \$300,000 of this money for deferred maintenance. Having determined that a new technology building is not feasible, Williamsburg Tech wishes to use the remaining \$700,000 for existing needs.

The State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education indicates this Bill will have no impact on the General Fund of the State or on Federal and/or Other Funds.



Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of South
Carolina:

SECTION 1. Item (f)(A)(4)(p) of Section 3 of Act 1377 of 1968,
as last amended by Act 322 of 2004, is further amended to read:

“(p) Williamsburg Tech -	
New Technology Building <u>Academic and Institutional Support</u>	
<u>Buildings Repair, Maintenance and Renovation</u>	700,000
Building Repairs	300,000”

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon approval by the Governor.
