(SDE: Technology Technical Assistance) Funds appropriated to the Department of Education for Technology Technical Assistance must <u>first</u> be used to <u>develop a statewide technology plan for schools and districts. The plan must address, at a minimum, infrastructure and connectivity needs, online testing requirements, equipment, educational technology, digital literacy and a statewide learning management system to connect teachers and students. The plan must take into account the need for some districts to utilize a regional approach to services that may include, but is not limited to, purchasing, training and support services. This plan including cost projections shall be presented to the Governor, the Chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee and the Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee by <u>February 1, 2020</u>, increase the capacity of districts who are or were the original trial and plaintiff school districts in the Abbeville law suit. <u>Remaining f</u>unds shall be used by the department to assist school districts and individual public charter schools may request a waiver from the State Board of Education from the requirement that all assessments be administered online.</u>
