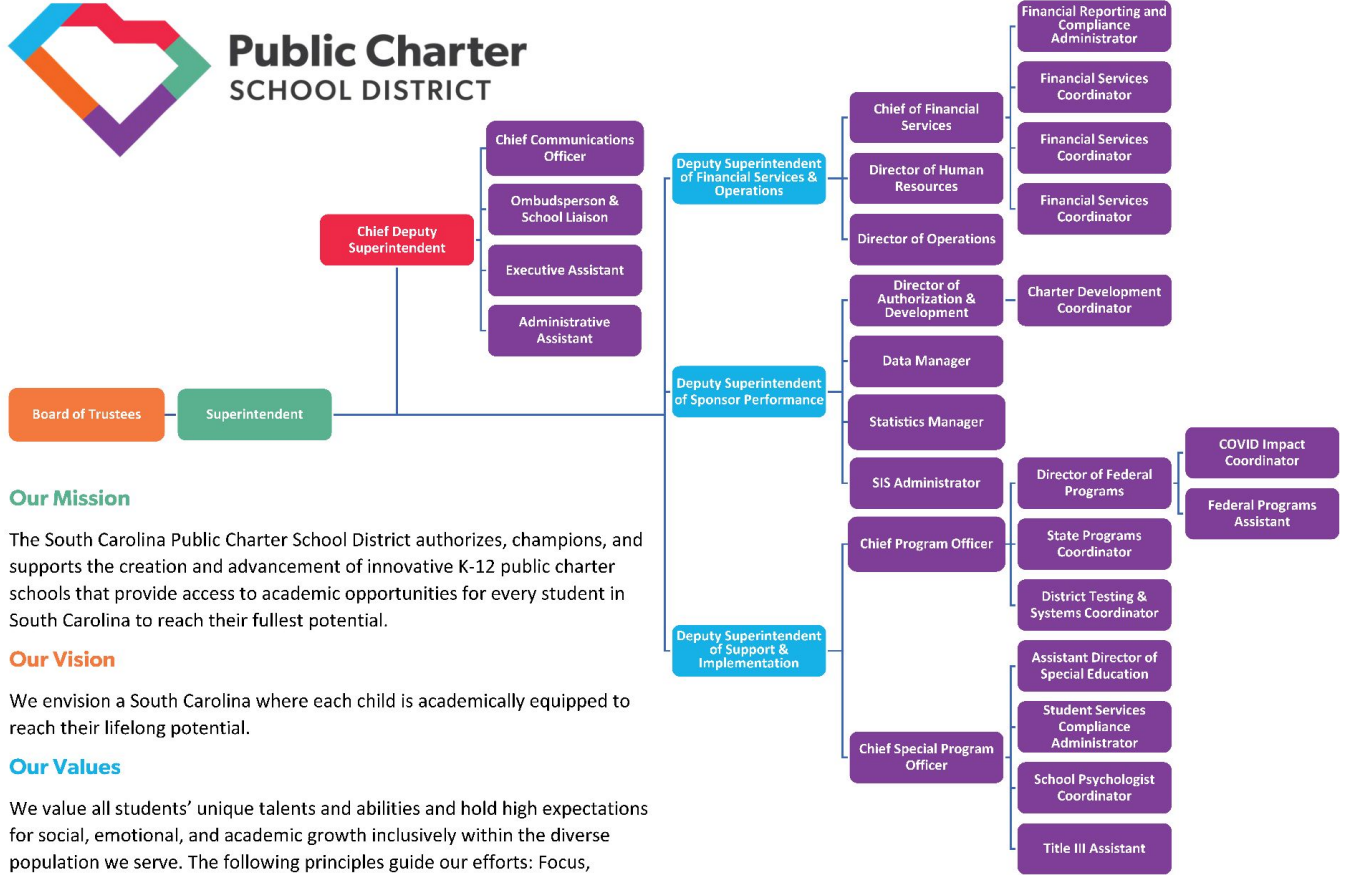

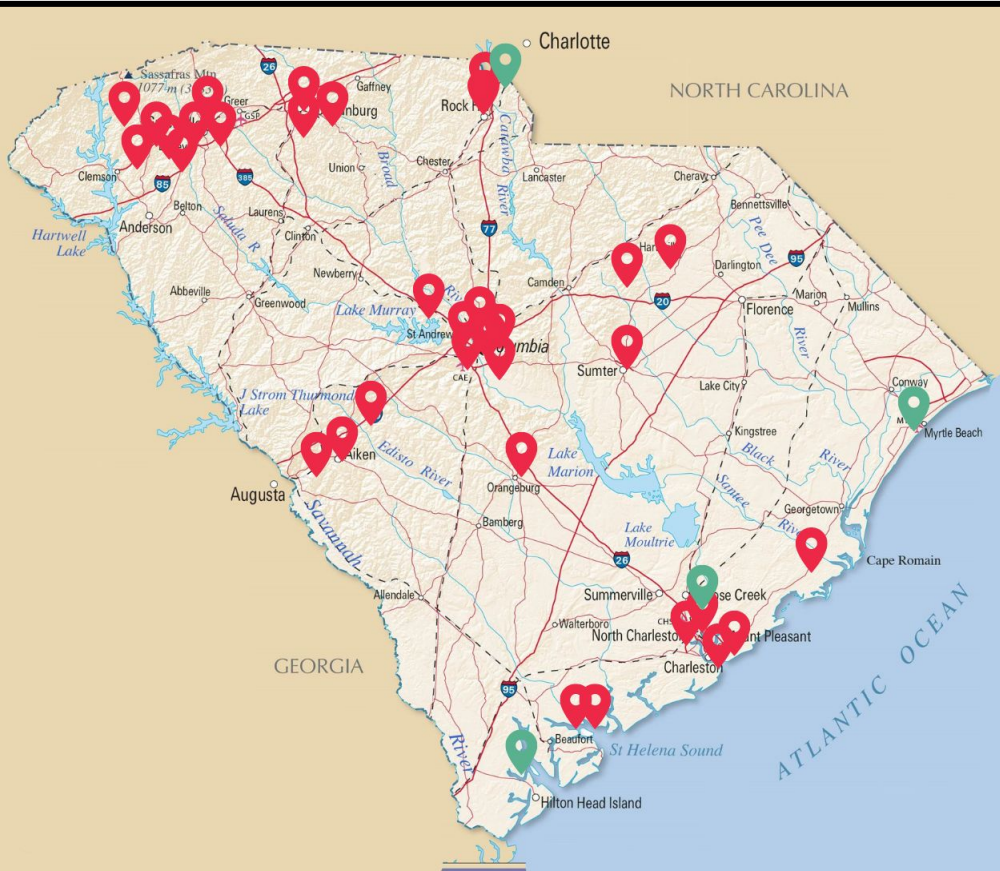
**Our Vision**

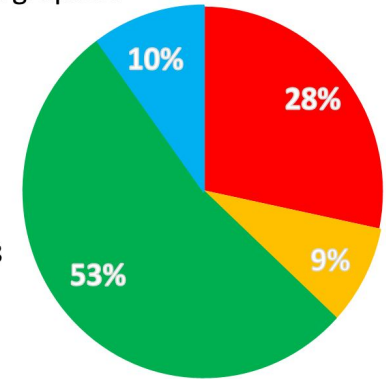

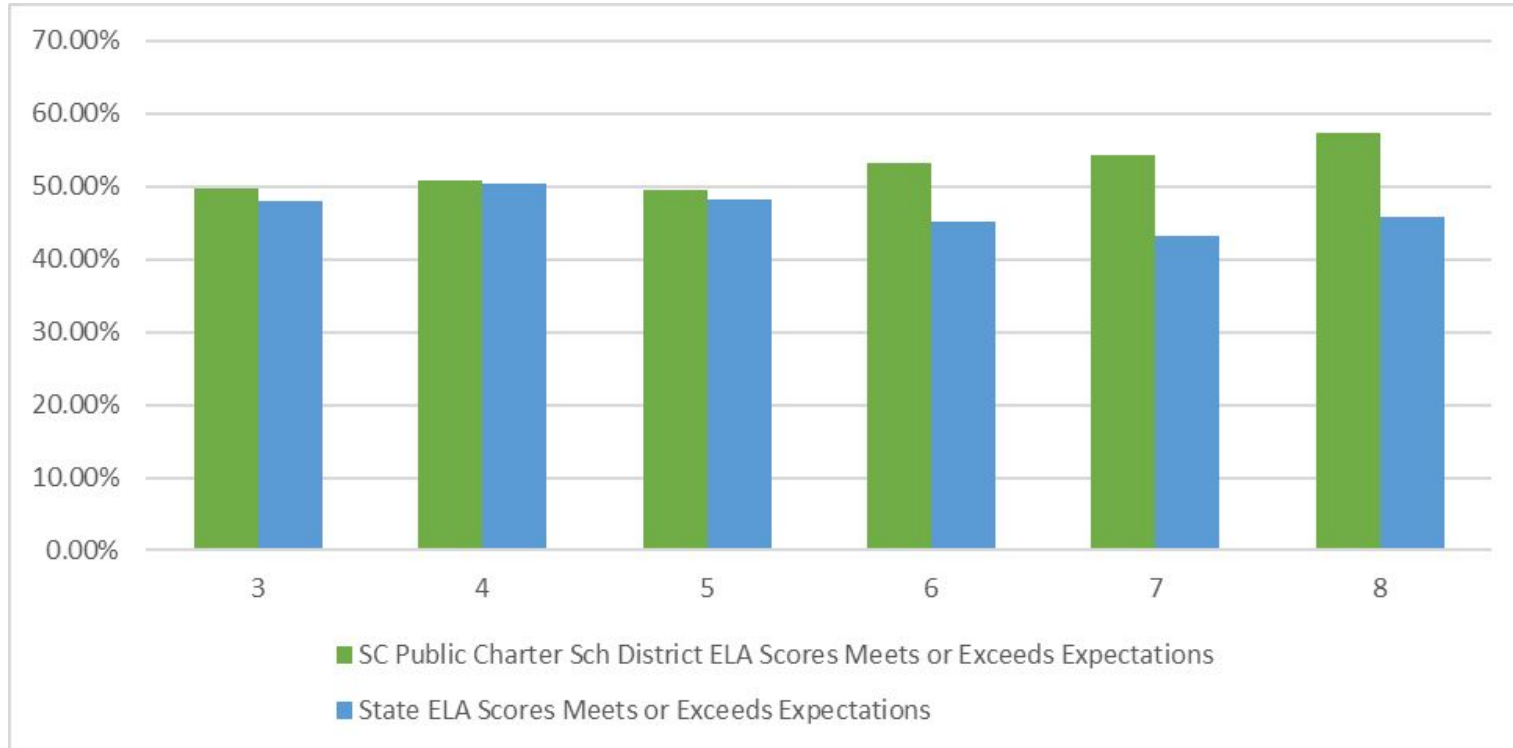

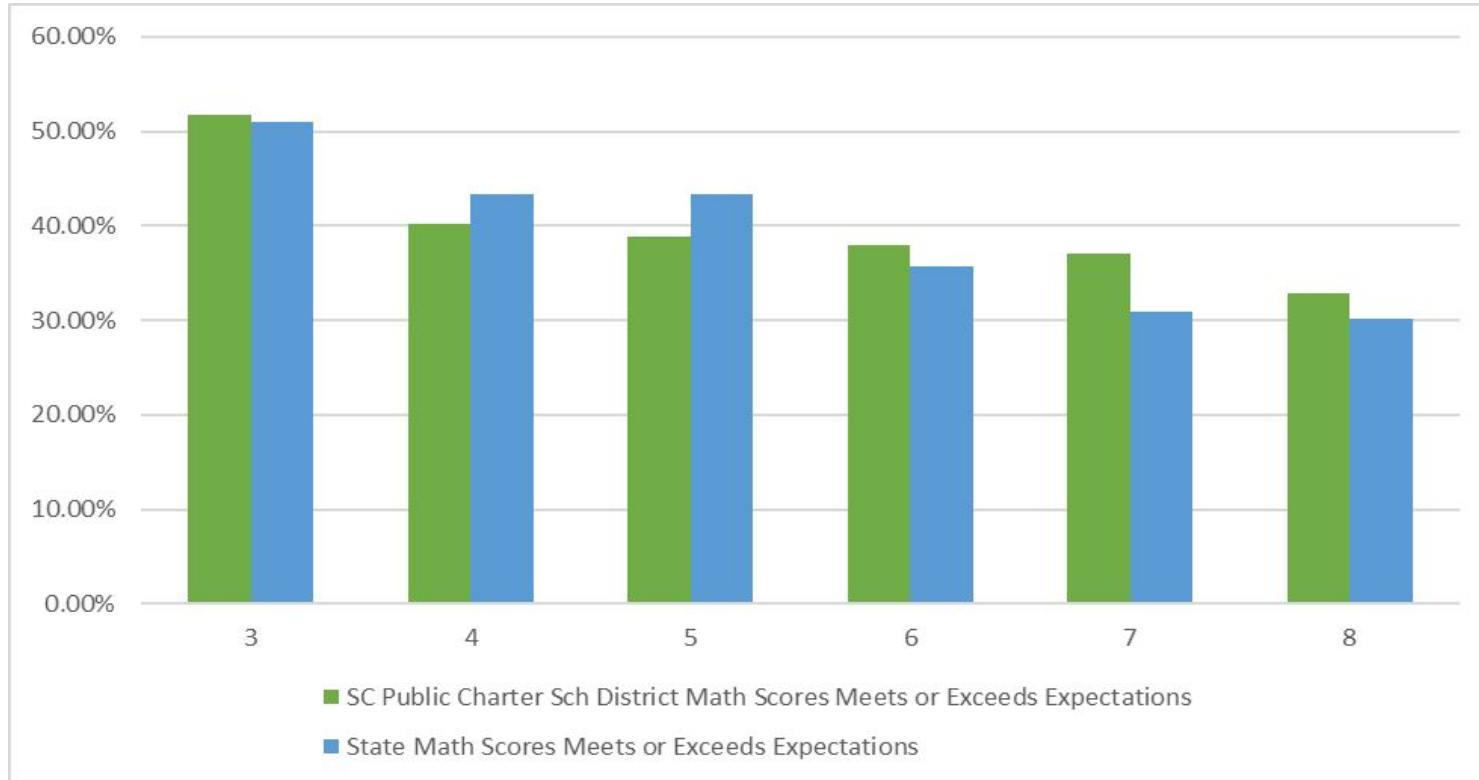
# SC READY 2022 District vs State

ELA Meets or Exceeds Expectations by Grade Level



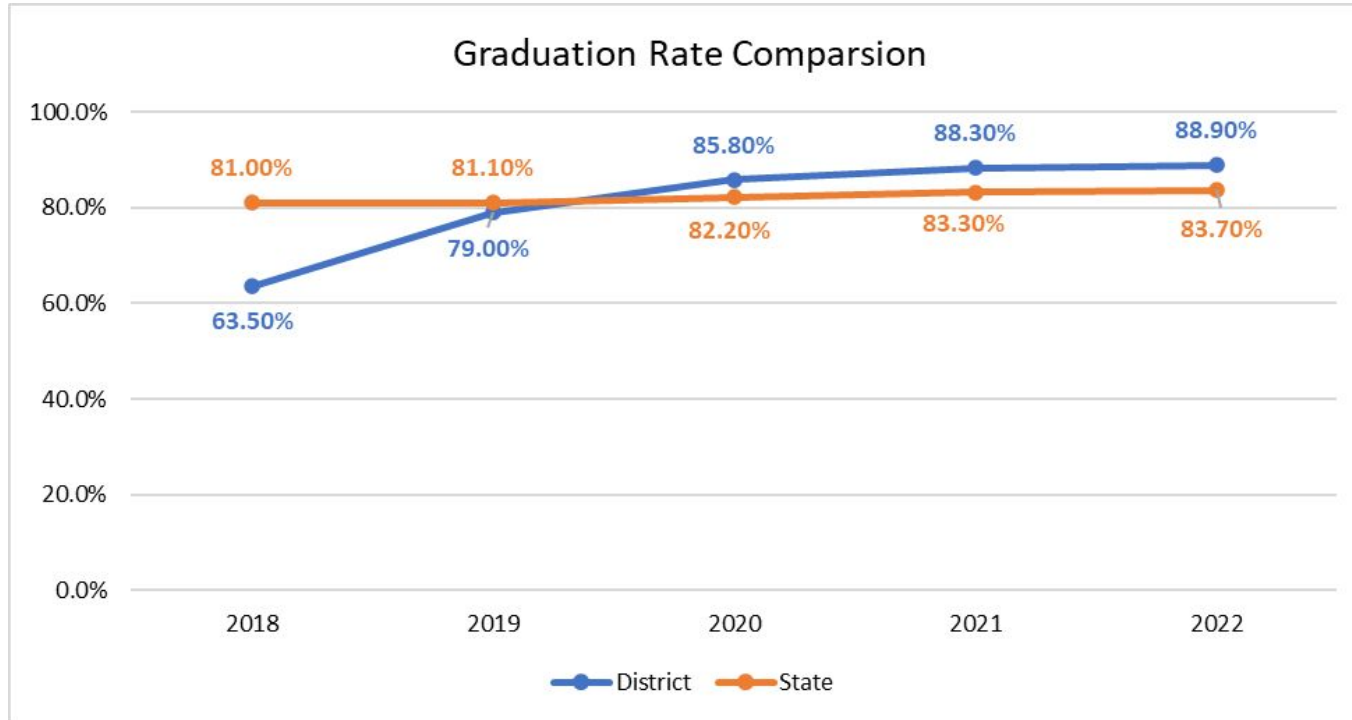

(District vs State)

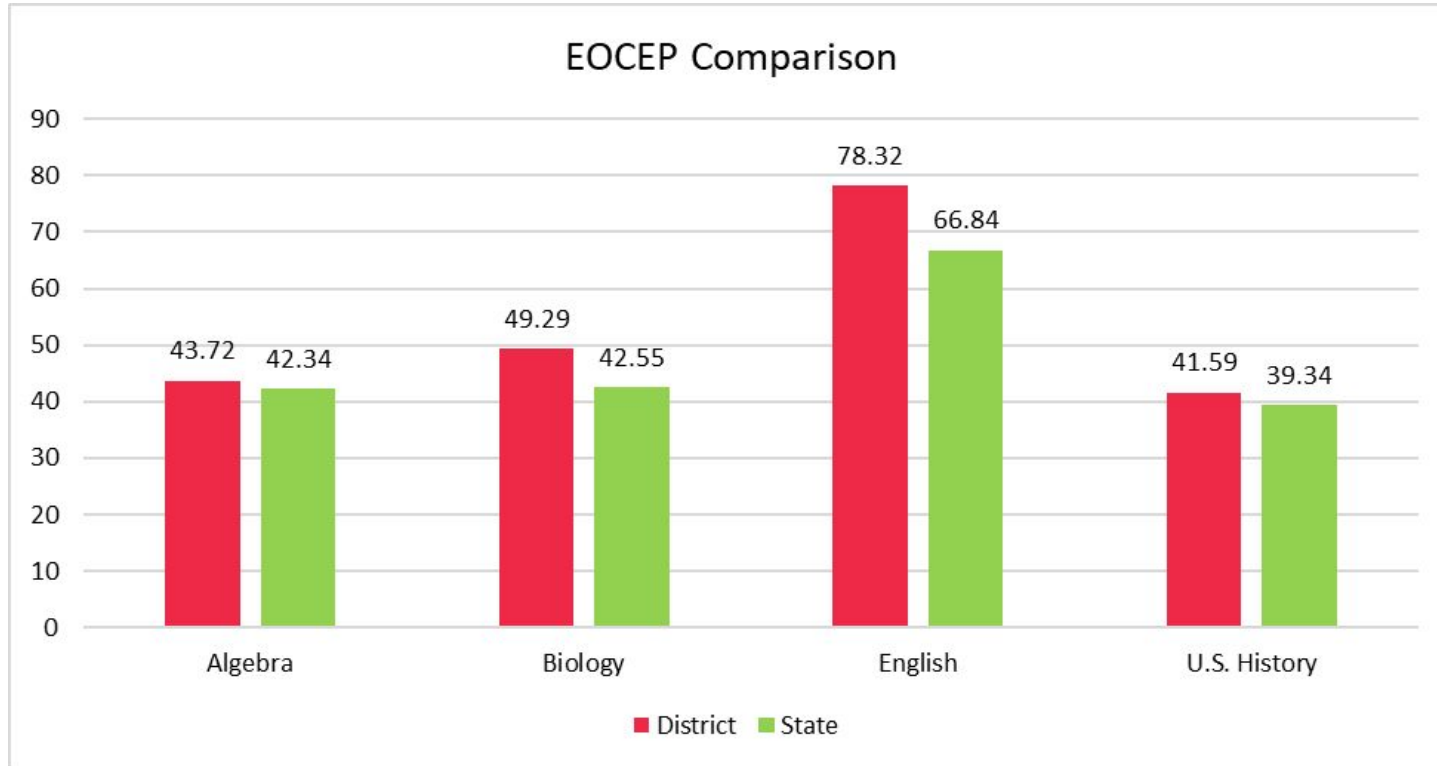

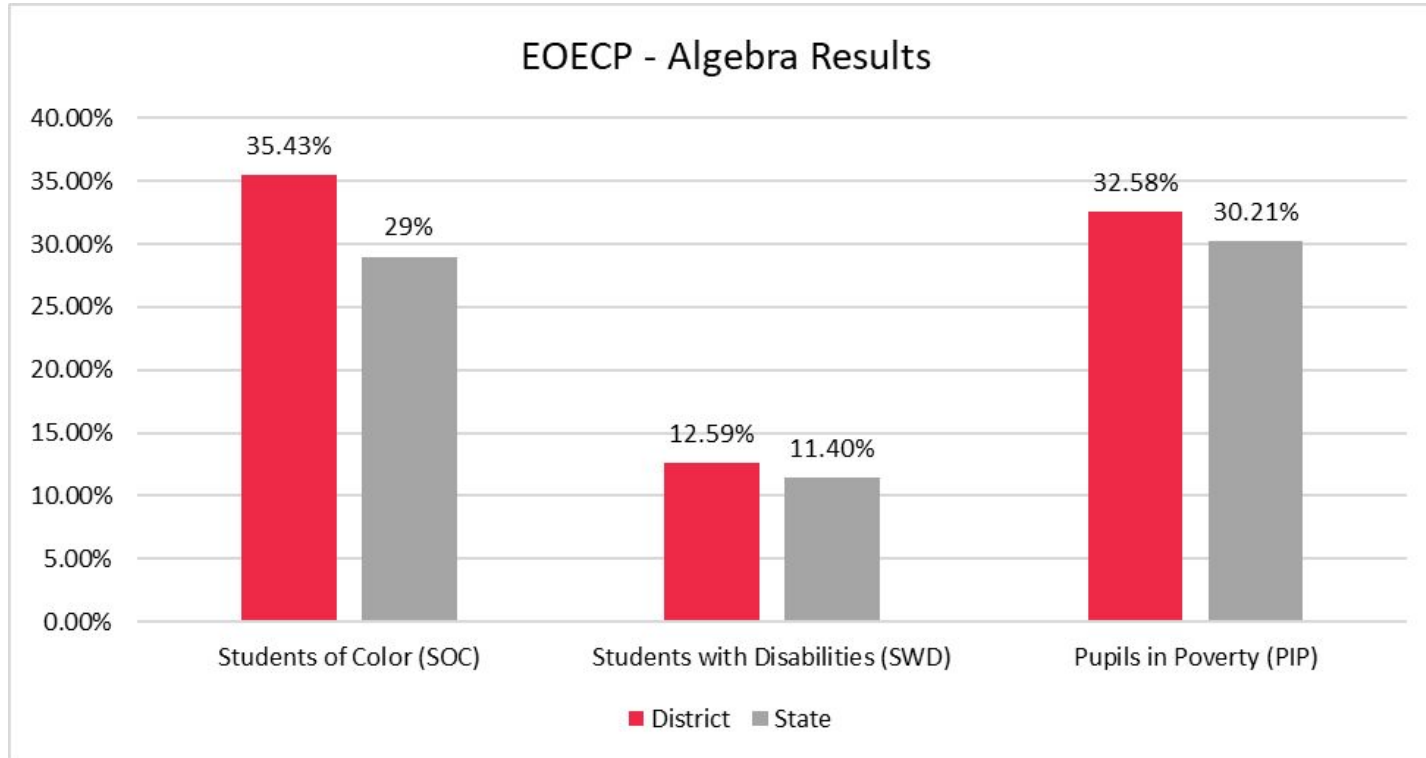
# 2021-22 End-of-Course Examination Program (EOCEP) Comparison

(District vs State, C or Higher)



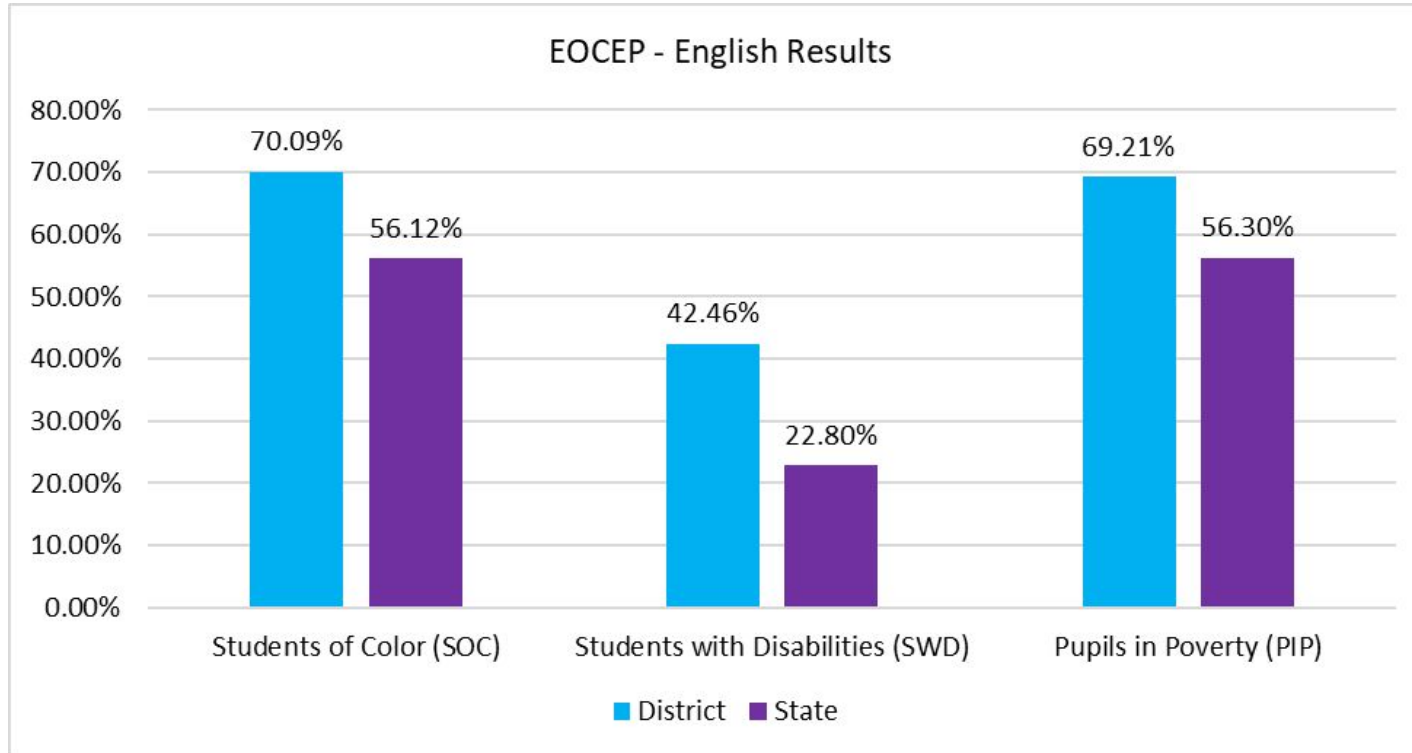

(District vs State - Key Subgroup Performance)



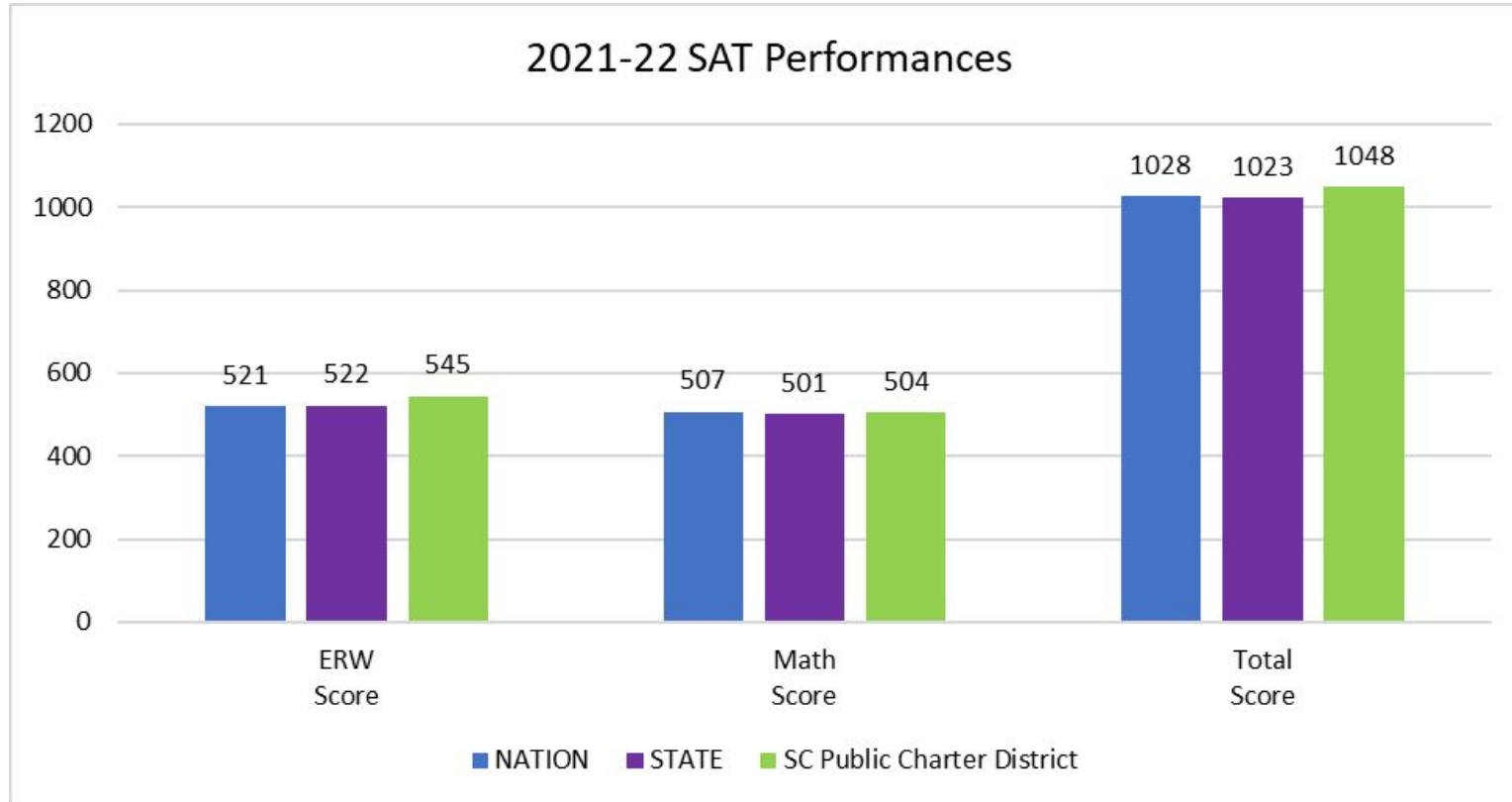

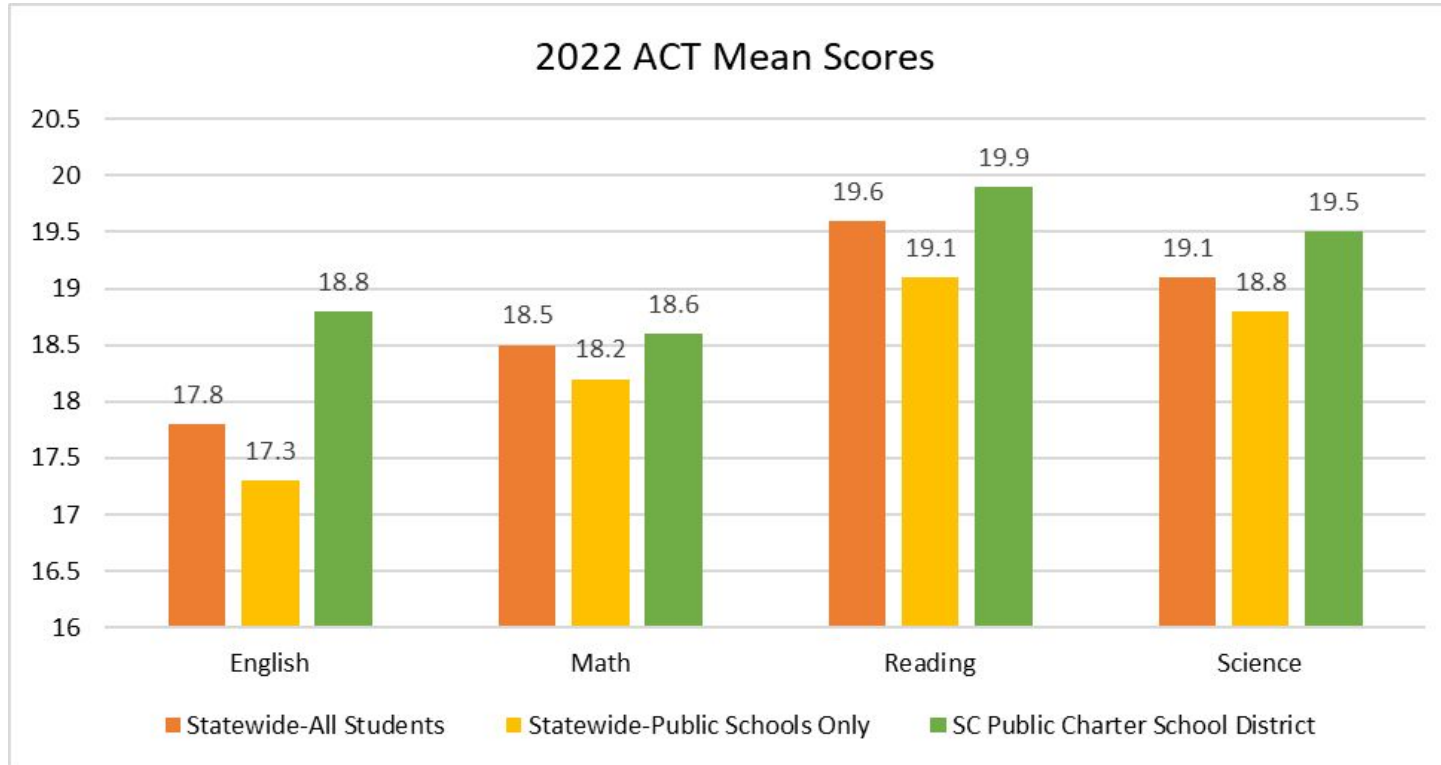
# 2021-22 SAT Results

(Nation vs State vs District)



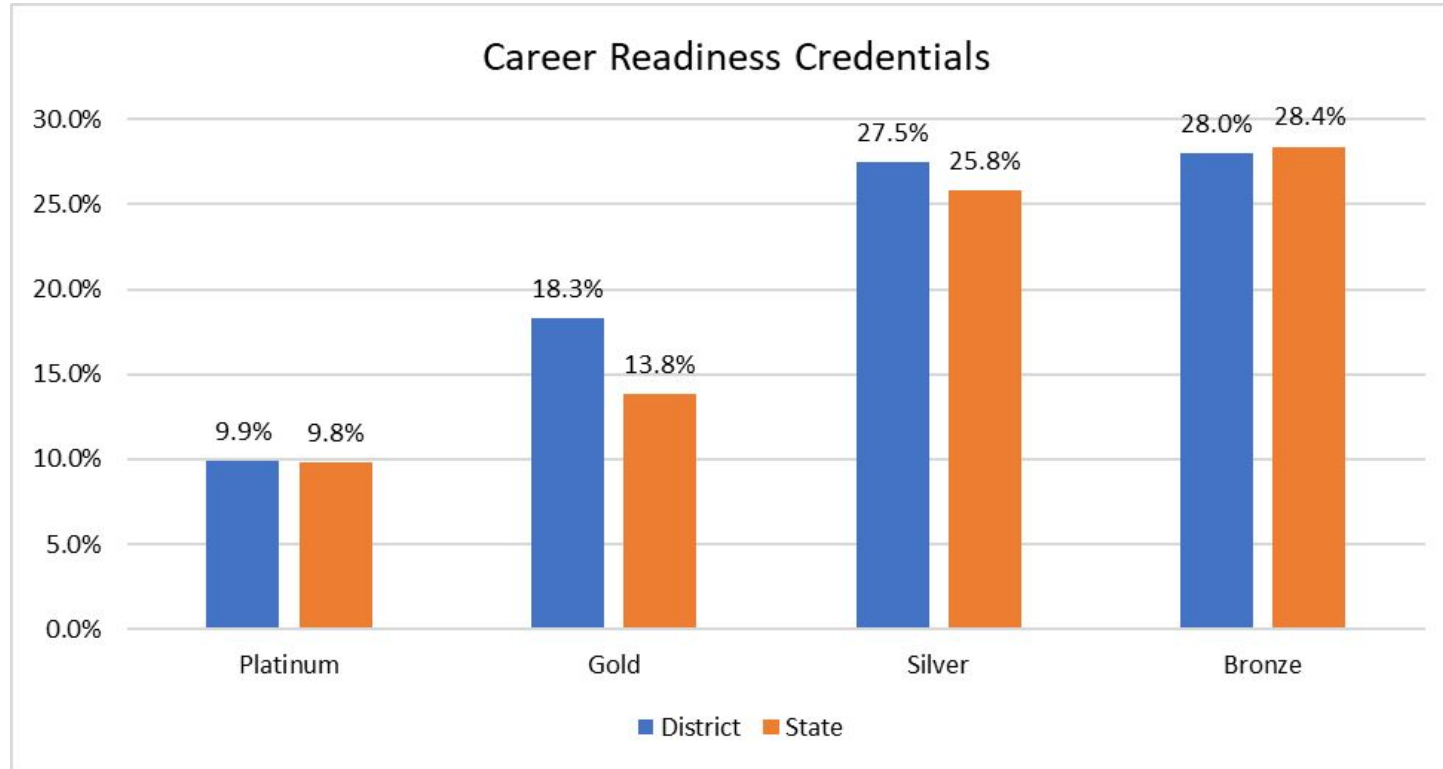
# 2021-22 ACT Results

# 2021-22 Career Readiness Credentials

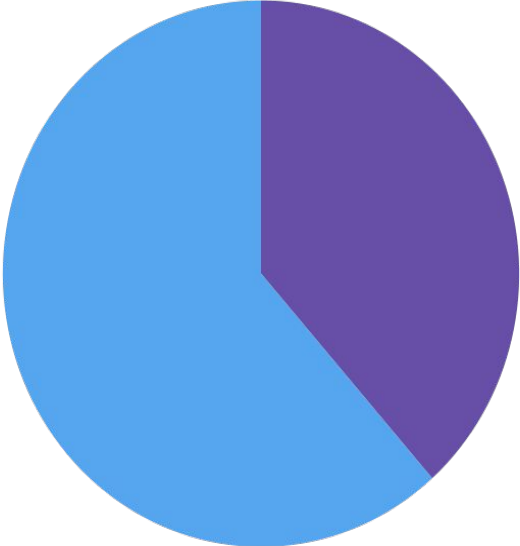

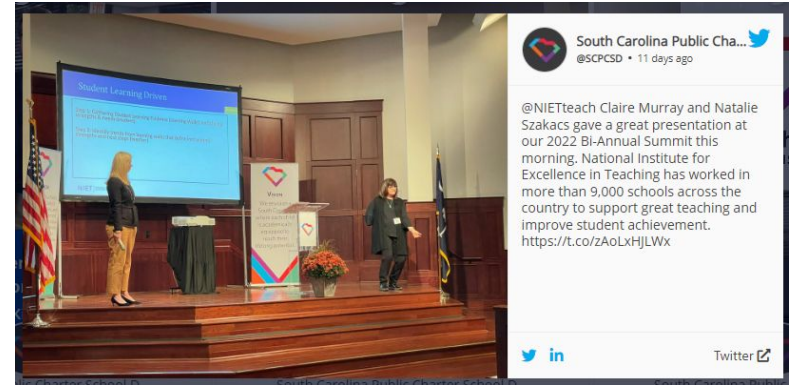
