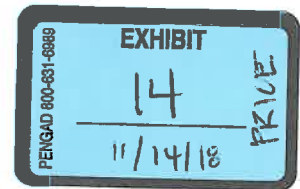


"Personal Data Questionnaire"



I previously submitted my PDQ in July of 2018. I am supplementing question number 45 to include a hunting without a license ticket from 1995.

45. Have you ever been arrested, charged, or held by federal, state, or other law enforcement authorities for violation or for suspicion of violation of any federal law or regulation, state law or regulation, or county or municipal law, regulation, or ordinance, or any other law, including another country's law? If so, give details but do not include traffic violations which are subject to a penalty of \$125 or less. You must include any and all arrests, including, but not limited to, offenses for driving under the influence or similar traffic offenses. Include all arrests that resulted in expungement, which will be redacted. If you have questions regarding whether to include an offense, please contact the Commission.

I was home on Christmas break from college in 1995 and was issued a citation for hunting without a license. I paid the fine and returned to college.

I was home on Christmas break from college in 1997 and I was issued a citation when I was in a boat with a friend that was cited for hunting after sunset. He shot a duck after the prescribed time and we were issued tickets for hunting after dark. I paid the fine and returned to college.

I was arrested at the age of twenty-one in Horry County on suspicion of driving under the influence. I was not under the influence. I retained an attorney who attended court on my behalf and the charge was dismissed without a plea to a lesser-included charge. I later had my arrest record expunged.
