
15. List five of the most significant litigated matters you have personally handled in either trial or appellate court or before a state or federal agency. Give citations if the cases were reported and describe why these matters were significant.
- (a) Pools Plus, Inc. v. Angela Timmons
2003-CP-43-1404
This was a jury trial in Common Pleas involving two other attorneys, besides me. I represented the Plaintiff swimming pool contractor for non-payment against the home owner. The home owner claimed defective work. The trial lasted several days and the jury returned a verdict in our favor. I also handled the appeal which affirmed the verdict in the trial court.
- (b) Randall Brummitt v. Patricia Brummitt
2008-DR-43-150
This was an alimony modification case. I handled the trial and the appeal. The case was argued before the Court of Appeals. Ultimately the action was not successful but it was a learning experience for me.
- (c) Primerica Insurance Co., Inc., v. Ray K. Ingram, Sr.
2002-CP-43-992
This case involved failure to pay life insurance benefits. I represented the Plaintiff beneficiary on the life policy. The carrier denied the claim based on misrepresentation by the insured. The trial court granted summary judgment and I appealed. The Court of Appeals reversed the judgment of the trial court. I received several compliments from local judges who read the opinion in the advance sheets.
- (d) Bessie C. Pringle and Burdy Pringle v. SLR, Inc. of Summerton, D/B/A Knights, Inn.
2005-CP-14-071
This was an appeal I filed for the Plaintiff after summary judgment was granted in the trial court. The case involved a slip and fall at a restaurant. I did not handle the case at the trial court level. The judgment of the trial court was affirmed but it was a learning experience for me.
