I. Report from Rep. Mark Smith, Chair Medical and Health Affairs Subcommittee

H. 3231 -- Reps. West and W. Newton: TO AMEND THE SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS BY REPEALING SECTIONS 44-6-300, 44-6-310, AND 44-6-320 ALL RELATING TO THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO ESTABLISH AND EXPAND CHILD DEVELOPMENT SERVICES.

H. 3232 -- Reps. West, W. Newton, B. Newton and Chapman: TO AMEND THE SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS BY AMENDING SECTION 44-115-80, RELATING TO FEES PHYSICIANS MAY CHARGE PATIENTS FOR COPIES OF MEDICAL RECORDS, SO AS TO REQUIRE CERTAIN MEDICAID PROVIDERS TO PROVIDE COPIES AT NO CHARGE.

H. 3508 -- Reps. Davis and G.M. Smith: TO AMEND THE SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS BY AMENDING SECTIONS 3-1-150 AND 63-3-510, RELATING TO JURISDICTION OVER CERTAIN LANDS RELINQUISHED BY THE UNITED STATES AND THE EXCLUSIVE ORIGINAL JURISDICTION OF THE FAMILY COURT, RESPECTIVELY, SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR CONCURRENT JURISDICTION WITH THE UNITED STATES IN CERTAIN MATTERS INVOLVING JUVENILES WITHIN A MILITARY INSTALLATION.
