Summary: Federal court judges, to be reconfirmed by U.S. Senate every ten years; Courts, Federal Government, Constitution of U.S.

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO MEMORIALIZE CONGRESS TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES AND SUBMIT TO THE STATES FOR RATIFICATION AN AMENDMENT TO REQUIRE ALL FEDERAL COURT JUDGES TO BE RECONFIRMED BY THE UNITED STATES SENATE EVERY TEN YEARS AND TO ENACT LEGISLATION ACCORDINGLY.
