### **S 1037 (Rat #0502) General Bill, By Leventis and Washington**

A Bill to amend Section 16-17-510, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the offense of enticing an enrolled child from attendance in public schools, so as to create a first offense violation of a fine of not less than five hundred dollars or imprisonment for not less than thirty days, or both, and a second or subsequent offense violation of not less than one thousand dollars or imprisonment for not less than two years, or both.-amended title
