A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 59-112-50, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE CIRCUMSTANCES UNDER WHICH CERTAIN MILITARY PERSONNEL AND THEIR DEPENDENTS ARE CONSIDERED ELIGIBLE FOR IN-STATE TUITION RATES, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT MEMBERS OF THE ARMED SERVICES OF THE UNITED STATES WHETHER IN ACTIVE, RETIRED, OR SEPARATED STATUS WHO ARE ADMITTED TO AND ENROLLED IN THE SOUTH CAROLINA TROOPS-TO-TEACHERS ALTERNATIVE ROUTE TO CERTIFICATION PROGRAM ARE ELIGIBLE TO PAY IN-STATE TUITION FOR THE REQUISITE PROGRAM COURSE WORK.
