S 1170 General Bill, By Campbell, Alexander and Rose

Summary: Pollution Control Act

A BILL TO AMEND CHAPTER 1, TITLE 48 OF THE 1976 CODE, RELATING TO THE POLLUTION CONTROL ACT, BY ADDING SECTION 48-1-95 TO PROVIDE THAT ALL SEWAGE SYSTEMS AND TREATMENT WORKS TREATING DOMESTIC SEWAGE THAT HAVE HAD THREE OR MORE SPILLS IN ANY TWELVE-MONTH PERIOD MUST COMPLETE A COMPREHENSIVE REVIEW OF THEIR OPERATIONS, TO PROVIDE FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE REVIEW, TO PROVIDE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF AN ACTION PLAN TO ADDRESS ISSUES RAISED IN THE COMPREHENSIVE REVIEW, TO PROVIDE SPENDING PRIORITIES FOR WASTEWATER UTILITIES THAT LACK FUNDS FOR IMPLEMENTING AN ACTION PLAN, TO PROVIDE THAT WASTEWATER UTILITIES THAT DEVELOP AN ACTION PLAN HAVE PRIORITY FOR STATE DIRECTED FEDERAL AND STATE FUNDS, TO PROVIDE THAT OWNER ERRORS THAT RESULT IN A SPILL MUST BE RECORDED ON THE OWNER'S LICENSE, AND TO PROVIDE NECESSARY DEFINITIONS.
