A Concurrent Resolution expressing the intent of the General Assembly that notwithstanding the provision of S. 546, the Comprehensive Health Education Act, the beginning date for instructional programs in reproductive health, family life education, and pregnancy prevention in the public schools of this State is January 1, 1989.
