

## Session 104 - (1981-1982)

**S\*0157 (Rat #0073, Act #0039 of 1981) General Bill, By J.R. Richardson, H.A. Chapman, W.W. Doar, J.V. Smith, D.S. Taylor and N.A. Theodore**

A Bill to amend Section 12-37-220, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to property exempt from ad valorem taxation, so as to exempt all personal property loaned or leased on a nonprofit basis to a state agency, county, municipality, political subdivision, or an organization exempt from income tax under Section 12-7-330, for at least thirty days during the tax year when such property is used solely for public display and not for the use of such state agency, county, municipality, political subdivision, or organization exempt from income tax under Section 12-7-330; and to provide that such property shall also be exempted from the provisions of Section 12-3-145 of the 1976 Code, relating to property tax exemptions.-at
