S 0018 General Bill, By Courson, Fair, Giese, Passailaigue and Setzler

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 11-11-440, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE LIMITATION ON TAX INCREASES AND NEW TAXES, SO AS TO REQUIRE THAT ANY GENERAL TAX INCREASE OR THE IMPOSITION OF NEW GENERAL TAX MUST BE ENACTED BY A VOTE OF AT LEAST TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS OF EACH HOUSE, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO TAXES REQUIRED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 13 OF ARTICLE X, OR TO PROVISIONS IN AN ACT TO BRING THE STATE INCOME TAX PROVISIONS OF THE 1976 CODE, AS AMENDED, INTO CONFORMITY WITH THE FEDERAL INCOME TAX CODE.
