A Bill to amend Chapter 35 of Title 12, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to retail license sales and use taxes, by adding Article 6 so as to levy a sales tax of two percent of the gross proceeds on the rental of transient accommodations, to provide the manner in which the funds generated by the tax may be expanded and provide a formula by which the funds are distributed to the municipalities and counties of this State.-amended title
