A Concurrent Resolution memorializing Congress to allow forest landowners who suffered tremendous loss as the result of Hurricane Hugo in 1989 the right to practice forestry without undue restrictions from the Endangered Species Act, wetlands statutes, and other laws and to provide, or to continue, certain other urgent relief.
