H 3340 Joint Resolution, By Seithel, R.C. Fulmer and H.M. Hallman

Similar (H 3075)

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to Article III, Section 2 of the Constitution of South Carolina, 1895, relating to the House of Representatives, so as to provide that House members may serve only four complete two-year terms and to provide that House members serving in office when this provision is ratified into law who have served at least four two-year terms may complete the term which they are currently serving after which they are barred from further service; and proposing an amendment to Article III, Section 6 of the Constitution, relating to the Senate, so as to provide that Senators may serve only two complete four-year terms, to provide that Senators serving in office when this provision is ratified into law who have served at least two four-year terms may complete the term which they are currently serving after which they are barred from further service, and to revise certain obsolete references.
