H 3510 General Bill, By Simrill

Summary: DUI, Blood alcohol content, percent of alcohol content decreased for guilt; Transportation, Traffic violations

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 56-5-2930, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION AGAINST OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE WITH AN ALCOHOLIC CONCENTRATION OF TEN ONE-HUNDREDTHS OF ONE PERCENT; AND BY AMENDING SECTION 56-5-2950, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO A DRIVER'S IMPLIED CONSENT TO BE TESTED FOR ALCOHOL OR DRUGS, SO AS TO REVISE THE TESTING PROCEDURE, AND TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON WHO HAS AN ALCOHOL CONCENTRATION OF TEN-ONE-HUNDREDTHS OF ONE PERCENT OR MORE IS CONCLUSIVELY PRESUMED TO HAVE AN ILLEGAL ALCOHOL CONCENTRATION.
