### **H\*3711 (Rat #0502, Act #0430 of 1984) General Bill, By J.J. Snow, R.L. Altman and Harvin**

A Bill to amend Section 50-13-1192, as amended, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to the use of nongame fishing devices in the freshwaters of the State, so as to allow the use of a maximum of fifty set hooks a license holder in the Black River.
