A Bill to amend Section 1-13-90, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, relating to complaints, investigations, and hearings filed with the Human Affairs Commission, so as to increase from ninety to one hundred twenty days the time a cause of action may be brought under certain conditions.-amended title
