A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 16-17-475 SO AS TO CREATE THE FELONY OFFENSE OF VOYEURISM BY PROHIBITING A PERSON FROM PHOTOGRAPHING, VIDEOTAPING, OR FILMING ANOTHER PERSON, WITHOUT CONSENT, IN A PLACE WHERE THE PERSON HAS A REASONABLE EXPECTATION OF PRIVACY; AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES AND EXCEPTIONS.
