### **H 4062 General Bill, By Murphy, McCoy, Crosby and Daning**

**Summary:** Pawnbroker pledged goods database created

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 40-39-85 SO AS TO CREATE THE "PAWBROKER PLEDGED GOODS DATABASE" TO SERVE AS A CENTRAL, STATEWIDE, ELECTRONIC REPOSITORY OF RECORDS CONCERNING GOODS RECEIVED BY A PAWBROKER IN A PAWN TRANSACTION, TO PROVIDE TIME LIMITS BY WHICH THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS MUST ESTABLISH THIS DATABASE AND BY WHICH A PAWBROKER MUST SUBMIT INFORMATION TO THE DATABASE, TO PROVIDE THE DATABASE MUST BE SECURE AND AVAILABLE TO LAW ENFORCEMENT, TO PROVIDE FOR REPORTING METHODS A PAWBROKER MUST FOLLOW IN THE EVENT RECORD REPORTING TO THE DATABASE IS NOT POSSIBLE DUE TO COMPUTER OR ELECTRONIC MALFUNCTION, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; AND TO AMEND SECTION 40-39-10, RELATING TO DEFINITIONS CONCERNING PAWBROKERS, SO AS TO DEFINE THE TERM "DATABASE".
