H 4239 General Bill, By F. Smith and McMahan

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 59-101-195 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT ANY MEDICAL STUDENT GRADUATING FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH CAROLINA MEDICAL SCHOOL OR THE MEDICAL UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH CAROLINA AFTER COMPLETING HIS INTERNSHIP AND RESIDENCY TRAINING MUST PRACTICE FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS IN A RURAL COMMUNITY HAVING A POPULATION OF LESS THAN TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND PERSONS IF THE STUDENT RECEIVED CERTAIN STATE OR FEDERAL GRANTS WHICH WERE APPLIED TOWARD HIS MEDICAL EDUCATION, AND TO PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS.
