H 4375 General Bill, By Townsend

Summary: Motor vehicle sunscreen devices, windshields; nonreflective types, light transmittance requirements

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 56-5-5015, AS AMENDED, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE SUNSCREEN DEVICES, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT A SUNSCREENING DEVICE INSTALLED AT CERTAIN LOCATIONS ON A MOTOR VEHICLE MUST BE OF A NONREFLECTIVE TYPE NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY PERCENT, TO PROVIDE THAT THE LIGHT TRANSMITTANCE REQUIREMENT OF THIS PROVISION DOES NOT APPLY TO WINDOWS BEHIND THE DRIVER ON PICKUP TRUCKS, AND TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CHANGE.
