H 4376 General Bill, By Townsend and Altman

Summary: Technical and Comprehensive Education Board, health and education programs, degree provisions

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 59-53-50, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE STATE BOARD FOR TECHNICAL AND COMPREHENSIVE EDUCATION, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE BOARD SHALL ASSURE THAT AN EXTENSIVE ALLIED HEALTH CURRICULUM IS AVAILABLE IN THE TECHNICAL AND COMPREHENSIVE EDUCATION SYSTEM TO MEET NEEDS ARISING FOR HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS BOTH FOR TWO-YEAR DEGREE PROGRAMS AND CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAMS, AND TO REQUIRE AN EXISTING EMPLOYEE OF THE BOARD TO BE ASSIGNED AS A HEALTH CARE EDUCATION COORDINATOR IN ORDER TO ASSIST IN ACCOMPLISHING THE ABOVE, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE DUTIES OF THIS COORDINATOR.
