A Joint Resolution to provide that the school days of January 10, 11, and 12, 1996, missed by the students of Cherokee School District 1 in Cherokee County for school year 1995-96 when the schools were closed due to snow and ice conditions are exempted from the make-up requirement of the defined minimum plan that full school days missed due to extreme weather or other circumstances be made up.
