H 4652 General Bill, By Lucas, McGee, McKay and Woodrum

Summary: Agencies, state; employee's social security numbers for form of identification; may submit alternative I.D., provisions

A BILL TO AMEND CHAPTER 30, TITLE 1, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF STATE GOVERNMENT, BY ADDING SECTION 1-30-130, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT ANY STATE DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY, WHICH REQUIRES A PERSON TO SUBMIT HIS SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER ON A FORM FOR ANY USE BY THE DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY, MUST OFFER A PERSON WHO OBJECTS TO SUBMITTING HIS SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER THE ALTERNATIVE OF SUBMITTING ANOTHER FORM OF IDENTIFICATION IN PLACE OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE ABOVE PROVISIONS DO NOT APPLY TO THE REQUIRED COLLECTION OF SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING, ENFORCING, AND COLLECTING CHILD SUPPORT OBLIGATIONS OR FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING STATE EMPLOYEE WAGES AND BENEFITS.
