Summary: State or local agencies overcharging person fee, tax, or charge due; refund provisions; Political Subdivisions, Taxation

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 8-21-25 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT ANY STATE OR LOCAL AGENCY OR DEPARTMENT WHICH IDENTIFIES A SITUATION WHERE A PERSON HAS BEEN OVERCHARGED A FEE, TAX, OR CHARGE DUE TO A MISTAKE ON THE PART OF THE AGENCY OR DEPARTMENT MUST REFUND THE OVERCHARGE TOGETHER WITH ANY REQUIRED INTEREST WITHIN A REASONABLE TIME BUT NO LATER THAN NINETY DAYS AFTER THE DETERMINATION BY THE AGENCY OR DEPARTMENT THAT IT WAS IN ERROR WITHOUT REQUIRING THE PERSON TO APPLY FOR SAME.
