### **S 0483 Joint Resolution, By P.B. McLeod and Peeler**

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to Section 3 of Article IV of the Constitution of South Carolina, 1895 relating to the election of the Governor, so as to provide that beginning in 1994, the Governor may not succeed himself in office but is re-eligible.
