Summary: Physical Therapy Examiners Board may suspend or revoke license for failure to refer patient to chiropractor

A BILL TO AMEND SECTION 40-45-110, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE BOARD OF PHYSICAL THERAPY EXAMINERS TO REFUSE TO GRANT AND TO REVOKE, SUSPEND, OR RESTRICT A LICENSE AND GROUNDS FOR SUCH ACTIONS, SO AS TO INCLUDE AS SUCH GROUNDS FAILING TO REFER A PATIENT, AMONG OTHERS, TO A CHIROPRACTOR WHEN THE PATIENT'S MEDICAL CONDITION WAS BEYOND THE SCOPE OF PRACTICE OF THE PHYSICAL THERAPIST AND TREATING A PATIENT WITHOUT A REFERRAL FROM, AMONG OTHERS, A CHIROPRACTOR.
