A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 59-17-170 SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT EACH LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT POLICIES TO ENSURE THAT PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO CONVEY OR DELIVER ANY MATERIALS THAT ADVOCATE FOR OR AGAINST A CANDIDATE, REFERENDUM, OR ANOTHER MATTER AND PROVIDE THAT A SCHOOL DISTRICT MAY NOT USE DISTRICT COMPUTERS, NETWORKS, WEB SITES, OR EMAIL LISTS TO CONVEY OR DELIVER THOSE MATERIALS; AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL MONITOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS ACT AND REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
