H 5008 Joint Resolution, By Fleming and Wilder

Summary: Radiation; certification requirements temporarily suspended for radiologic technologists to use ionizing radiation on humans for diagnostic or therapeutic purposes

A JOINT RESOLUTION TO SUSPEND THE CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS OF ACT 101 OF 1999, WHICH REQUIRES AN INDIVIDUAL TO BE CERTIFIED BY THE SOUTH CAROLINA RADIATION QUALITY STANDARDS ASSOCIATION TO USE IONIZING RADIATION OR EQUIPMENT ON HUMANS FOR DIAGNOSTIC OR THERAPEUTIC PURPOSES.
