### **S\*0613 (Rat #0451, Act #0398 of 2006) General Bill, By Fair and Hutto**

**Summary:** Nonprofit organization special license plates

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 56-3-630, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, RELATING TO VEHICLES CLASSIFIED AS PRIVATE PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLES, SO AS TO REVISE THE TYPE OF VEHICLES THAT ARE CLASSIFIED AS PRIVATE PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLES; TO AMEND SECTION 56-3-8000, RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES, SO AS TO REVISE THE PROCEDURE WHEREBY THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES MAY ISSUE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES; TO AMEND SECTION 56-3-8100, RELATING TO THE PRODUCTION AND DISTRIBUTION OF SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES, SO AS TO REVISE THE PRODUCTION AND DISTRIBUTION PROCEDURE; TO AMEND SECTION 56-3-8200, RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF ROTARY INTERNATIONAL SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES, SO AS TO REVISE THE FEE FOR THIS SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE; TO AMEND SECTION 56-3-8300, RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF MARINE CORPS LEAGUE SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES, SO AS TO REVISE THE FEE FOR THIS SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE AND ITS DISTRIBUTION; TO AMEND SECTION 56-3-5400, RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES, SO AS TO SPECIFY WHICH INDIVIDUALS MAY OBTAIN AND DISPLAY THIS SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE AND TO PROVIDE A PENALTY; TO AMEND CHAPTER 3, TITLE 56, RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION AND LICENSING, BY ADDING ARTICLES 57, 59, 63, 64, 65, 66, 67, 68, 69, AND 75, SO AS TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES MAY ISSUE "UNITED STATES NAVAL ACADEMY SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES", "UNITED STATES AIR FORCE ACADEMY SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES", "SUPPORT OUR TROOPS SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES", "EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES", "BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES", "NATIVE AMERICAN SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES", "SOUTH CAROLINA PEACH COUNCIL SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES", "KOREAN WAR VETERANS SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES", "CANCER RESEARCH CENTERS OF THE CAROLINAS SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES", AND "SOUTH CAROLINA AQUARIUM SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES"; TO AMEND SECTION 56-3-670, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE DEFINITION OF A FARM TRUCK, SO AS TO REVISE THIS DEFINITION; TO AMEND SECTION 56-3-1110, RELATING TO WARTIME DISABLED VETERAN LICENSE PLATES, SO AS TO REVISE THE CRITERIA FOR THEIR ISSUANCE; AND BY ADDING ARTICLE 98 TO CHAPTER 3 OF TITLE 56 SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF GOLD STAR FAMILY SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES. - ratified title
