Summary: Public officers, state employees; immediate family defined in cases of death or sickness of relative, sick leave

A BILL TO AMEND THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, BY ADDING SECTION 8-11-150 SO AS TO GRANT UP TO THREE DAYS OF PAID LEAVE FOR STATE FULL-TIME PERMANENT OR PROBATIONARY EMPLOYEES ON THE DEATH OF A MEMBER OF THE EMPLOYEE'S IMMEDIATE FAMILY, AND TO DEFINE IMMEDIATE FAMILY TO INCLUDE THE SPOUSE, GREAT GRANDPARENTS, GRANDPARENTS, PARENTS, AUNTS, UNCLES, BROTHERS, SISTERS, CHILDREN, GRANDCHILDREN, AND GREAT GRANDCHILDREN OF THE EMPLOYEE OR THE SPOUSE; AND TO AMEND SECTION 8-11-40, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO STATE EMPLOYEE SICK LEAVE SO AS TO INCLUDE AUNTS AND UNCLES IN THE DEFINITION OF IMMEDIATE FAMILY FOR PURPOSES OF USING SICK LEAVE TO CARE FOR ILL FAMILY MEMBERS.
