A Concurrent Resolution memorializing the members of South Carolina's Congressional Delegation to become the first Congressional Delegation in the United States to promise publicly to refrain in the future from accepting gifts and gratuities from lobbyists and to support legislation prohibiting the giving and receiving of lobbyists' gifts and gratuities to members of Congress and their staff members and employees.
